





There are several editions of this book listed but only three ISBNs are used. The hardback has four listed editions, all use 978-0903895262. The original Corgi (1975) edition used 978-0552999564. When Robson Books brought out their own edition a new ISBN, 978-0860512868, was used. This continued to be used in the 1998 and 2002 editions later in 2002 the book was brought out as a Black Swan edition with the same ISBN as the original Corgi edition (1975). On the face of it, it looks like there were two editions available from two different publishers in 2002, Robson and Black Swan.

Both Corgi and Black Swan are part of Transworld Publishers who are in turn part of the Random House Group. Probably the style of the book more suited Black Swan than Corgi in 2002.
