

Milligan by Numbers

This is just to give another view of the breadth and depth of Milligan in print.

These numbers are all approximate. Precise numbers are complicated by definitions, e.g. publisher versus imprint. Do I count every different imprint as a publisher? I haven't.

The total number of Milligan books printed is an underestimate. Assuming there are 326 editions of Milligan books, assuming an average print run of 15,000 copies gives us a total figure of 4,890,000. But some editions were reprinted multiple times.
