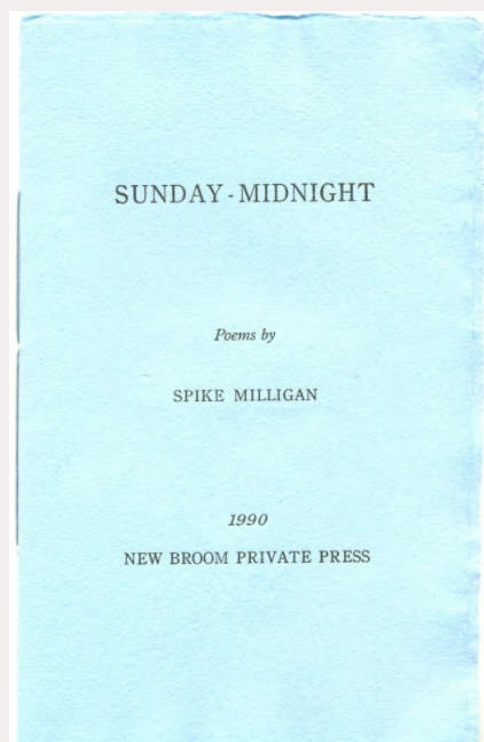
Sunday-Midnight; (also published as a Phoenix broadsheet)

There is confusion surrounding this chapbook. Firstly the title poem Sunday-Midnight was also printed as Phoenix Broadsheet no 344 also in 1990.

The second confusion is the size of it. It is listed in libraries as 4pp, 5pp, 6pp and 8pp. Physically the item consists of two folded sheets sewn together to give four leaves. Thus the pagination is 8 pages. As there is no written pagination some cataloguers may have recorded different values – if they discount the outer pages of the cover it is 6 pages; discounting the cover completely it is 4 pages. I don’t have an explanation for the reference that gave 5pp.
