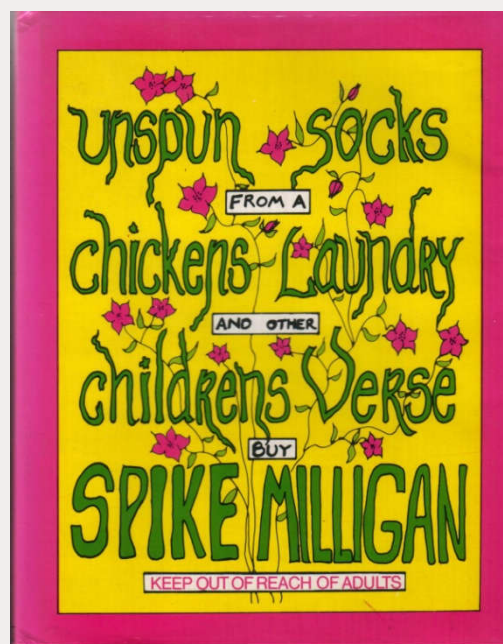

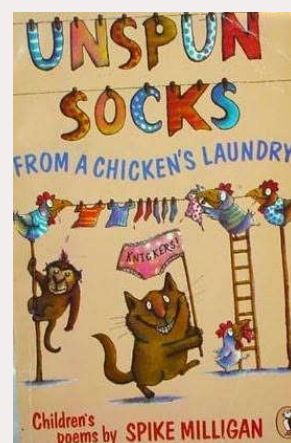

This miniature edition was third of three volumes in The Mini Milligan Collection slip case edition published by Puffin in 1992.

Although the original paperback is only 75 pages it is a larger dimension paperback book (B format) than the others in this series.
